DuPont de Nemours Plans to Cut 3% of Global Workforce

DuPont de Nemours is planning to cut 3% of its workforce as part of a global cost reduction plan, according to the LCGB trade union. The company has reportedly not confirmed which sites will be affected by the cuts. The trade union said the Luxembourg industrial sector is being hit once again by the risk of a deterioration in employment in the sector and has urged the future government to take this into consideration and to "quickly" bring together the different actors to take stock of the situation in the sector and to "seriously reflect" and agree on the actions and measures to be taken. The union stressed the need to consider and implement all support measures to preserve the 850 jobs in Luxembourg.

Taiwan: Vietnamese manufacturing workers pay high recruitment fees, while remediation falls short despite zero-fee recruitment policies, incl. cos. comments

In June 2022, The Diplomat reported migrant workers employed by manufacturers in Taiwan supplying to European multinationals paid extortionate recruitment fees and experienced other labour rights violations, including withheld passports and fines. An article published in August 2023 outlines the relationship between the suppliers and buyers. Chin Pool Industrial supplies car parts to Bosch, Hella, General Motors, Opel, Magna, Visteon, and Continental. Shinkong Synthetic Fibers supplies plastics to Continental and Niagara Bottling, who makes bottles for companies including Walmart. Dutch State Mines and Dupont also sourced from Shinkong until the end of 2022. The August article also found the two suppliers reimbursed over \$2.5 million to the migrant workers for recruitment fees paid Vietnam and Thailand. However, it notes migrants were paid only between 20% - 60% of their recruitment costs. thus going against the zero-recruitment fee policies of many of the companies buying from those suppliers.

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Public Prosecution Service starts investigation against DuPont/Chemours [NL]

The Public Prosecution Service (OM) has launched a criminal investigation against chemical company DuPont/Chemours in Dordrecht, following a report submitted by lawyer Bénédicte Ficq on behalf of around 2,400 people. The complaint focuses on the intentional release of PFAS substances into air, soil and surface water from 1967 to the present day. The investigation will consider whether there is criminal liability of the managers of the company. The investigation is in the early stages and is expected to take some time to complete. Separately, DuPont/Chemours is already subject to a criminal investigation into possible excessive exposure of employees to PFOA in the period up to 2012.

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New Collective Agreement Agreed for Dupont Staff

A new collective agreement has been agreed at Dupont de Nemours' Luxembourg site, according to the LCGB trade union. The agreement will benefit around 840 staff and is valid for three years, from 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2025. The agreement includes unique bonuses, merit average increases, an increase in holiday pay, conversion of regular public holidays for shift workers, an increase in the supplement for daily temporary transfers, and various simplifications and updates to texts with new provisions of the collective agreement. The agreement provides for a one-time bonus of €500 to each employee in March 2023, and a single bonus of €750 to each employee in March 2024 and 2025. Chemical Makers Settle PFAS-Related Claims for \$1.19 Billion

DuPont de Nemours, Chemours and Corteva have reached an agreement in principle to pay \$1.19bn to settle claims that they contaminated US water systems with perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which do not break down easily in the environment. The three companies, which deny the allegations, expect to finalise the agreement in Q2 2023. Chemours will pay half of the amount, with the remaining sum provided by DuPont and Corteva. The agreement resolves claims made by hundreds of US water providers, who say they are responsible for cleaning up PFAS contamination from firefighting foams. It does not cover personal injury claims or claims involving pollution at water systems owned by states or the federal government.

DuPont has been sentenced for criminal negligence in relation to a 2014 accident in which four employees died. On 15 November 2014, DuPont released 24,000 pounds of the highly toxic, flammable gas methyl mercaptan into the air. The chemical release also injured other DuPont employees and spread downwind into surrounding areas. The company has been ordered to pay a \$12m penalty and will serve two years of probation, during which time it must give the US Probation Office full access to all of its operating locations. It will also make a \$4m community service payment to the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation. DuPont has also paid \$19.26m for unlawful conduct in other related cases.
