



Rules for the DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards

Rules

Applications:

1. Consideration will be given to applications submitted by legal entities having executed an exemplary initiative in the field of safety, sustainability or operational excellence.
2. Applications shall be programs, projects or contributions, containing important innovations or implementation of improvements focusing on safety, sustainability or operational excellence.
3. Prizes will be awarded in three different categories:
 - A – Safety
 - B – Sustainability
 - C – Operational Excellence

Documentation:

4. Applications and summaries of the projects must be sent, in English and in electronic format (Word, Acrobat, PowerPoint) to:

5. In addition, you may send up to 2 supporting documents (i.e. Powerpoint presentations). Each supporting document must be limited to 15 pages each. Supporting documents in excess of 15 pages will not be considered within the assessment of the application.
6. The full application required for participation in the 2017 DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards is as follows:
 - Brief description of the company and its trajectory, including activities in the field of safety, sustainability or operational excellence – maximum 1 A4 page (3'000 characters).
 - Application form with a brief summary of the project – maximum 3 A4 page (10'000 characters).
 - Any supporting documents (see point 5).

Deadline for applications:

7. The Letter of Intent to submit for an award must be submitted before April 23, 2017.
8. The complete application, as described in points 4-6, must be received by the Independent Organizing Committee before May 31, 2017 at 18:00 local time in Geneva, Switzerland. Only applications which follow the required formats and deadlines will be considered.



Rules for the DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards

Procedure:

9. The Independent Organizing Committee will nominate the Jury, constituted by outstanding personalities in safety, sustainability or operations.
10. The Independent Organizing Committee will also nominate the President of the Jury.

The Jury will choose one winner per geographic region – (1) the Americas, (2) Europe, Middle East and Africa or (3) Asia Pacific. Applications will be assessed according to the following criteria:

- Performance Improvement – What results were achieved? Demonstrate using key performance indicators (KPIs)
- Visible Management Commitment – How has management played a role in achieving the positive outcome?
- Sustainability of the Initiative – What measures were included to ensure the continued success of the initiative?
- Cultural Improvement – What cultural elements were leveraged, and how did they contribute to the sustainability of the initiative?
- Stakeholder Engagement – How were stakeholders – internal or external – engaged to deliver the positive outcomes?

The jury will then select a global winner in each category from the three regional winners. The global winner will be announced at the award ceremony.

11. The Jury's decision will be adopted through simple majority of votes. In case of a draw, the vote of the President shall be predominant. The Jury may decide not to award a prize in one or more categories.
12. The Jury's decision shall be definitive and final. This decision will not be subject to any appeal, and no further details will be communicated.
13. The Jury will emit its final verdict by the end of July 2017.
14. DuPont Sustainable Solutions will deliver its DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards to the most deserving applications, based on the Jury's decision.

Presentation of Awards:

15. The Awards will be officially presented in the autumn of 2017.

Rule acceptance:

16. Participation in the DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards presupposes the full acceptance of the present rules and their content.
