Adjuvants such as methylated seed oil (MSO) may be added for improved coverage and residual.

Apply when populations reach local established treatment thresholds to prevent crop damage.

Do not make more than two sequential applications of PREVATHON® before rotating to another registered insecticide having a different mode-of-action
