Always read this FIFRA 2(ee) bulletin and the entire label of the product container before using this product. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe; consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation. Do not apply this product in any way that will contact workers or other persons; either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

DuPont™ CORAGEN® insecticide is recommended for the control of grasshoppers in grass forage, fodder, and hay: any grass, Gramineae family (rangeland & pasture grass).

Apply CORAGEN® at 2.0 to 4.0 fluid ounces per acre (0.026 - 0.052 lb a.i. per acre) as a foliar spray via aerial application or ground application. For best results with foliar sprays, add Methylated Seed Oil (MSO) adjuvant at 1 gallon per 100 gallons of spray volume (1% v/v).

Apply when grasshopper populations reach local established thresholds to prevent crop damage: typically above 8 grasshoppers per square foot. Correct timing of spray applications to nymphal stages and thorough coverage is critical to achieve optimum control. For best results applications should be made when eggs have hatched and the majority of the grasshopper population is 2nd – 3rd instar nymphs.

Read and follow all spray drift management guidance in the Federal Section 3 CORAGEN® label.

Once grasshoppers contact and/or ingest CORAGEN® there will be rapid feeding cessation; full expression of mortality may take a week or more.

Do not make more than two sequential applications of CORAGEN® before rotating to another registered insecticide having a different mode-of-action.

## PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply more than 15.4 fluid ounces of CORAGEN® per acre (0.2 lb a.i. per acre) per year.

Do not make more than 2 applications per acre per crop. The minimum retreatment interval is 7 days.

The preharvest interval is 0 days. The field re-entry interval is 4 hours.
