A jury of experts drawn from Emerson, DuPont, the International Organization of Employers (IOE), and Health & Safety at Work magazine, among others, will evaluate projects according to criteria such as management involvement, cultural evolution, performance improvement, innovation and stakeholder engagement. All applications should demonstrate measurable results and improvements that can be gauged through defined key performance indicators.

Since its launch in 2002, the biannual DuPont Safety and Sustainability Awards competition has grown to become a global event attracting entries from a wide range of industries and countries (from France to Germany, Italy, Kazakhstan, Saudi Arabia, Turkey and the United Arab Emirates).
