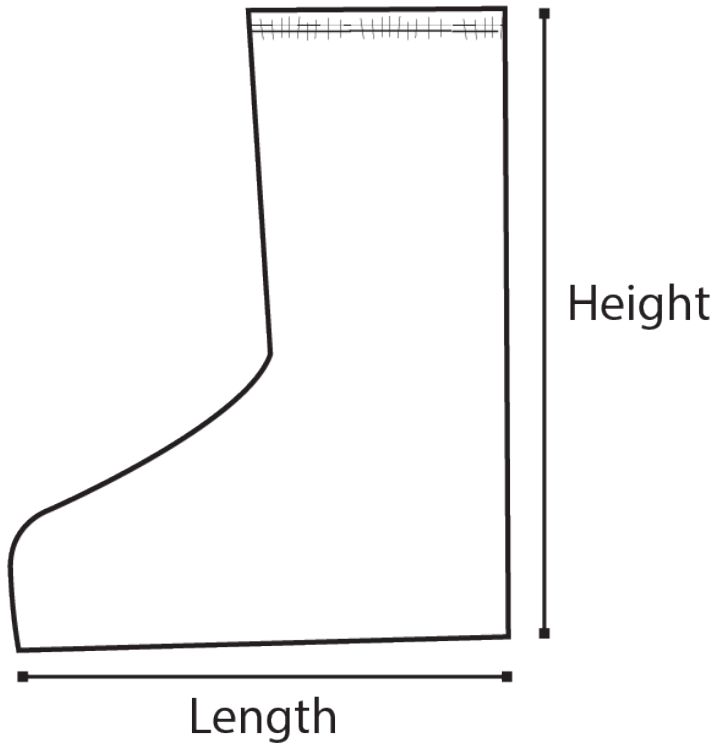

- The garment shall be gray in color.
- The garment shall be a boot cover design.
- The garment shall have serged seams.
- The garment shall have an elastic opening.
- The garment shall have a ProShield® 70 upper.
- The garment shall have soles made of skid-resistant material.
- The garment shall be 10™ high.

SPECIAL WARNINGS

- *Serged and bound seams are degraded by some hazardous liquid chemicals, such as strong acids, and should not be worn when these chemicals are present.
- *Liquid barrier performance varies based on the amount of liquid that may get on the garment, the length of time the liquid is on the garment, applied pressure and certain physical properties of the liquid.
